Dear Preserve at Somers Home Owner:

The Home Owners Association Board is writing this letter to you in an attempt to keep you up-to-date on the issue of speeding within the Preserve. In a meeting with the Town Highway Supervisor on Friday, January 14th, the Supervisor tentatively agrees with the installation of stop signs at the following locations:

- Loomis Drive & Putney Road (4-way)
- Travis Road and Vista Drive (3-way)
- Travis Road and Putney Road (2-way, no sign on Travis Road facing rt. 118)

The Town Highway Supervisor does not agree with our request to install stop signs at the following locations:

- Loomis Drive and Turk Drive
- Travis Road and Bassett Drive

He views our request to install signs at these locations to be speed deterrents; it is his belief that stop signs should be used to raise awareness of potentially hazardous situations.

Further, his tentative agreement does not mean the signs will be installed. The Chief of Police and the Town Engineer must review and approve the request.

The HOA board will present our request for stop signs during the next Town Of Somers Board Meeting. In the interim, please voice your opinion of this effort by using the Traffic, Roadways and Speeding forum, located in the main forum system at **forum.preserveatsomers.org**.
