Subject: Additional Stop Signs in the Preserve at Somers

Several weeks ago, the town highway supervisor met with members of the HOA board to review what is believed to be the consensus request from our homeowners regarding stop signs. This includes:

- Full 4-way stop at Loomis and Putney
- Full 3-way stop at Travis and Putney
- Full 3-way stop at Travis and Vista

The supervisor has tentatively agreed to:

- Full 4-way stop at Loomis and Putney
- 2-way stop at Travis and Putney

The HOA board feels that making the intersection of Travis and Putney a 2-way stop would become confusing, and create an even greater hazard. Also, not installing any stop signs at the Travis/Vista intersection will perpetuate a problem caused by the speed that cars build coming down the hill from Putney, and the blind curve as you pass Vista going back towards Loomis.

This request must still be reviewed by the town Engineer as well as the Chief of Police; Even this scaled-down version of the original request is not a "done deal".

The Town Board will hold a Public Hearing to review our request for stop signs, and to hear from the public.

The only way to get our initial request granted is to show up to this hearing in mass. A large showing of our residents will show our elected town board that we are serious about our request.

If this is a subject that is important to you (for or against), please plan to attend this important hearing at Somers Town Hall (The Elephant Hotel) on March 10th beginning at 7:30p.
